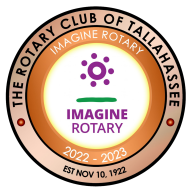

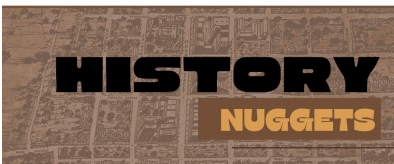

## History Nugget

In 1944-45, during the last year of World War II, Doak Campbell presided over the Rotary Club of Tallahassee at the same time that he presided over the transformation of the Florida College for Women (with 1800 students when he started in 1941) into coeducational Florida State University (with over 8000 students when he retired in 1957).



## MAJOR SERVICE PROJECTS THROUGH THE YEARS

Clark Durrance, 1962 – 63 was president when the Rotary scholarship house on W. Pensacola St. was chartered on October 18, 1962 with a down payment of \$1500. The Tallahassee Democrat on that date featured a picture of Pres. Durrance handing a check to Dean Mode Stone of the Southern Research and Scholarship Foundation. The club raised the money for the first year's mortgage by having fish fries at Lake Hall and at the Junior Museum. The club bought the fish and members purchased \$10 tickets. Members held workdays on Saturdays to paint the house both inside and out and also did carpentry to make the home comfortable for 15 young men.
